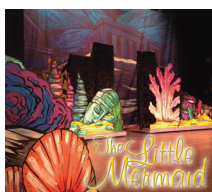


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Hans Christian Anderson's The Little Mermaid **Oct 1, 2025 10am (Pre K-4th)**
